4. Cheques and postal orders to be made payable to Durham County Badminton Association
5. Clothing must meet Badminton England's Tournament Regulations
6. Competitors will be notified of the start time of their first match, and if they are not available when called to play, they will be scratched.
7. A fee of £5 is payable if an entry is cancelled. Players must inform the referee at least 36 hours before the start of play or the whole fee will be forfeit. Refunds will only be considered if applied for in writing within 14 days after the tournament.
8. Feathered shuttles will be used throughout the tournament.
9. Awards will be made to Winners and Runners-up.
10. The tournament will be run in accordance with BADMINTON England's Tournament Regulations.
11. The Referee's decision on all matters will be final.
